Purpose and Overview (max. 5 sentences)

The purpose of the course is to introduce students to the basic engineering and technological terminology with the aim of creating a professional basis for further instructions in English for specific academic purposes with the development of the existing knowledge of general English. The course comprises reading and comprehension of engineering texts with a particular emphasis on terminology, comparing and contrasting the native and foreign language for specific purposes, and enabling students to use scientific and professional literature independently.
