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Предмет: Могућност сарадње са Сукмјонг женским универзитетом

Као део активности Амбасаде на плану јачања међууниверзитетске сарадње са Р. Корејом, јуче је на једном од најпрестижнијих женских универзитета у земљи, Сукмјонг женском универзитету (SMWU), одржан састанак амбасадора Н. Грбића са ректорком Универзитета проф. Мун Шик-јон, те проректорком проф. Ким Ђи-ун и деканом Факултета за глобалне студије будућности проф. Мун Хјун-намом.

Амбасадор је представио богато академско наслеђе Србије и истакао кључне институције високошколског образовања у нашој земљи, попут Универзитета у Београду. Током састанка су размотрене могућности образовне сарадње у домену високог школства попут програма студентске и размене предавача, као и других заједничких иницијатива на обострану корист. Потврђена је посвећеност обе стране потенцијалним заједничким пројектима, уз договор да се одржавају блиски контакти и размотре формални облици сарадње који би омогућили шире академско повезивање и мобилност студената у оба правца.

SMWU, смештен у Сеулу, широко је препознат као прва приватна женска образовна институција у Кореји основана под покровитељством корејске царске породице. Универзитет је основан 1906. године најпре као женска школа „Мјонгшин“, а 1938. године добија име „Сукмјонг“, те је временом израстао у свеобухватну институцију која данас броји 11 факултета, три независна основношколска одека и располаже развијеним системом постдипломских студија. Са изузетном историјом која обухвата период касне династије Ђосон и модерну еру, SMWU се може похвалити сталним унапређењем инфраструктуре и академског квалитета, као и највишом стопом запошљавања дипломаца међу женским универзитетима у Сеулу (64,4% у 2020. години). Иако не поседује сопствени медицински факултет, његов „Life Systems Department“ је познат по одличном програму припреме за медицинске студије, а универзитет се непрестано развија како би одговорио на све комплексније потребе високог образовања у Кореји. Посебно је препознат по квалитетним студијама фармације, економије и права.

На крају разговора, председница Мун је изразила намеру да позове амбасадора да студентима одржи предавање о Србији током марта или априла. Посета Универзитету закључена је кратким обилазком кампуса.

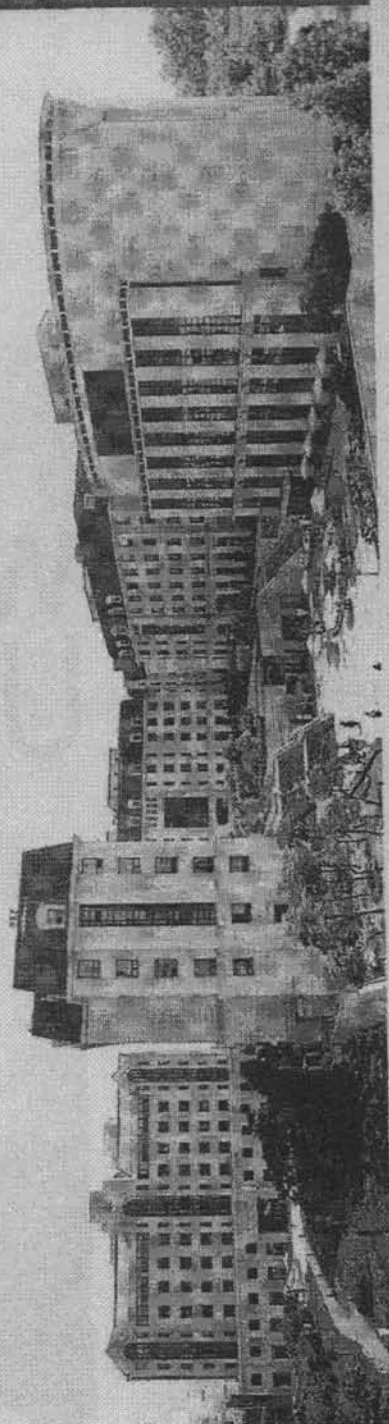

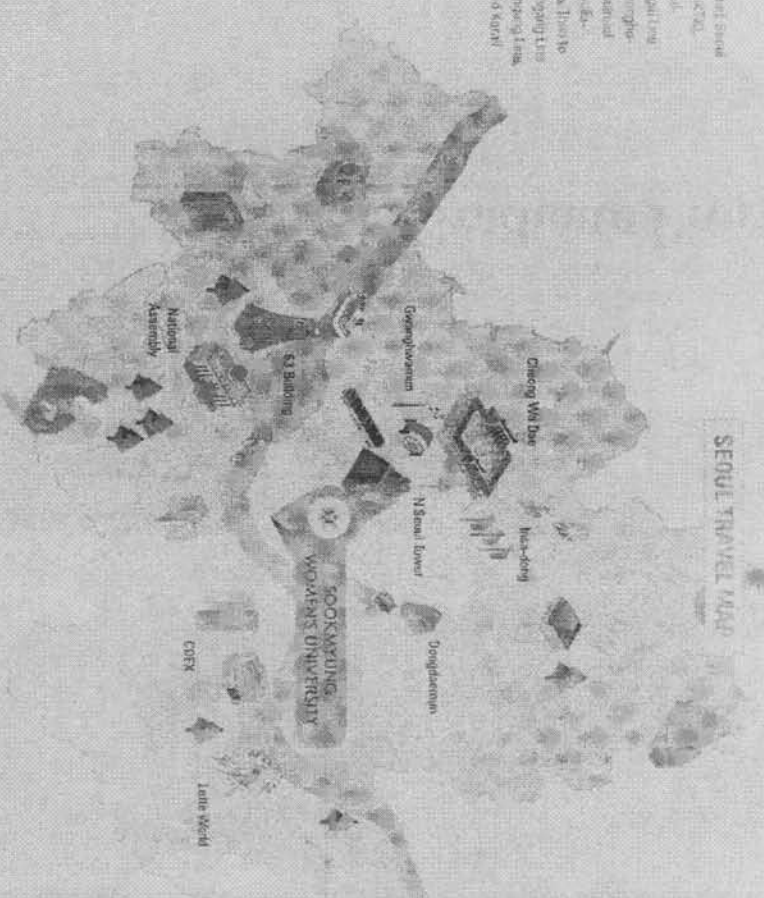

Global Peer Mentor Program matches international students with Sookmyung Mentors within the same major. This one-on-one relationship provides international students with a useful guidance in their major program.

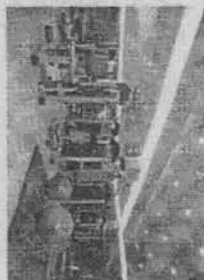
CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

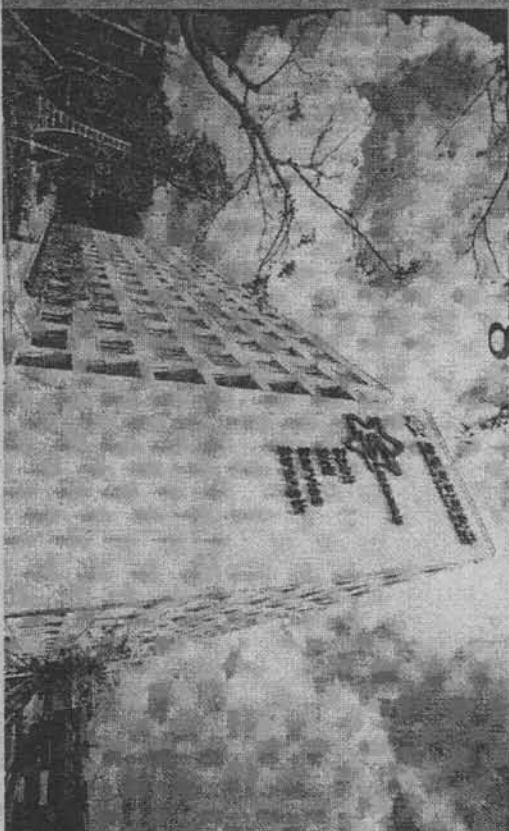

The dormitory provides shared refrigerators for student use, lounge areas, a computer room, and laundry facilities (washing machines and dryers). 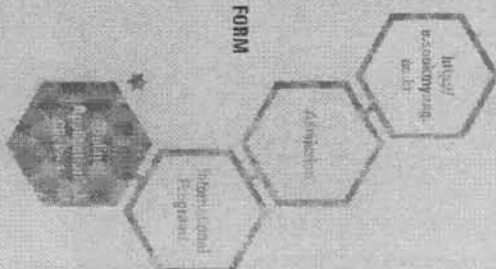

SOOKMYUNG INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL (SISS) (JULY-AUGUST / 3 WEEKS)

Sookmyung Int'l Summer School (SISS) offers students an exciting Korean college life with motivated and brilliant students as well as an opportunity to experience traditional cultures in and outside campus. SISS provides lectures on various topics and also focuses on the particular subjects related to Korea.

DUAL DEGREE PROGRAM

Sookmyung is the first Korean university to offer Dual Degree Program that allows students to earn degrees from two institutions at the same time.

VISITING STUDENT & STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

SCHOLARSHIP FOR EXCHANGE PROGRAM

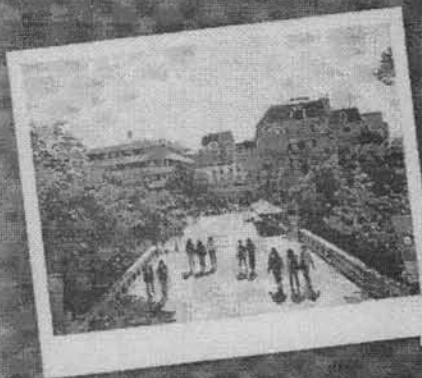

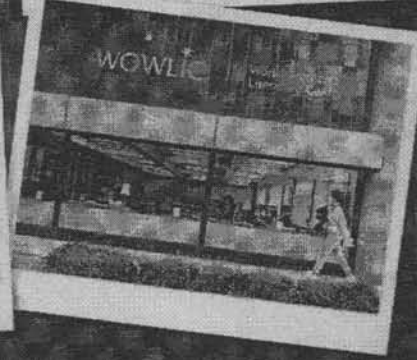
